

Here is the latest on charitable deductions for taxes this year in case anyone asks you if there is a tax advantage to giving to Theatre West:

The law hasn't changed with regards to charity deductions, the same rules apply. You either take your itemized deductions, which included charitable donations or you take the standard deduction that the IRS allows for 2018.

The issue with the "new" tax laws are that for a married couple the standard deduction for 2018 and beyond is \$24,000. Single people get half of that, \$12,000.

So, if you don't have enough itemized deductions, which many people don't, they will take the higher amount which of course makes sense.

For individuals who won't be taking more than \$12,000 in deductions this year, they may not be incentivized to give to TW as a tax write off so they'll need to be inspired to give for YOU!!!It is Annual Appeal time for us. Another great month at Theatre West! Dina Morrone's solo show did really well and the second night of TURKEY TALES set the tone for the holiday season for the company!

A special thank you goes out to Dina Morrone for producing the *Portraits of Humanity 2* solo show series. It's been a lot of work, on top of putting up her own show. We're seeing lots of new faces as a result! Shout out to Linda Rand, too, for putting on the Sundays at 7 monologues again this year. She too has put in a lot of time and hard work so members can perform and get us all in the holiday spirit.

Cash flow has been a little better this month thanks to a lot of hard work put into fundraisers and rentals for the past 2 months. Linda Rand produced, TO DAD WITH LOVE, George Tovar and Jeanine Anderson produced MILLENNIUM MAGIC XIX, Dina Morrone is producing the PORTRAITS OF HUMANITY 2 solo series, and Tom Mendola did a concert for us. We have to fundraise constantly in order to meet our high overhead every month. Rent is \$4,100 a month, utilities average \$1,000 a month, insurance is over \$2,000 a month, and Payroll is about \$6,000 a month. We couldn't have made it it this year without people pitching in to fundraise, donating their time and talents to make sure that the lights stay on. 
