Nikola Tesla - was he a wizard, showman, prophet, charlatan, magician, father of the 20th century, or a little of each?





Make sure you indicate how much time you need and who else will be in the scene with you. Be sure to save.

NOTES FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR



Congratulations to the cast and crew of **The Ugly Duckling**. Yesterday was the last day of the show. We've still got some field trips coming up through the end of the school year, but the Saturday shows are over for now. If you haven't seen the youtube of **The Princess and the Frog** that David Johnson uploaded, go to the public page and take a look at the post for Throwback Thursday. He's uploading all of the shows that Lloyd and Barbara had professionally produced about 11 years ago. Check out his youtube channel for more.

Reminder: Whenever we open ourselves up to the public for a show, please keep talk of company business out of the lobby, etc. We don't want people to accidentally overhear stuff that is meant for our ears only! We want people to leave talking about our great shows - not our stinky laundry!

The board and I met for a vision retreat and it went really, really well. We talked about what we have going for us that no other theatre companies have, our proud 55 year history, what theatre means to us and how we can work with other companies in building and strengthening the theatre community in Los Angeles as a whole, benefits of membership, ideas on how to attract new members, and what we need to do to be more effective as a board.

We worked on updating the rules and regulations, a plan for managing volunteers during this transition period, and how to be more effective in communicating who we are to the general public.

Theatre West is the only membership theatre company that has 164 seats, a children's theatre, programs for schools, rental opportunities, workshops to develop projects and nurture artists, main stage productions, and as of this year, a children's theatre summer camp. This sets us apart from all other theatre companies in Los Angeles. We have it all.
