

#### WRITERS WORKSHOP PLAY READING SERIES

Theatre West Writer's workshop will be starting a play reading series in 2019 for full-length plays (Over 75 minutes).

This reading series is for plays in development in the Writers Workshop to have their first public readings. The readings should be done simply, with not much staging, to give the play a chance to be heard. These will be new plays, and should be seen with that in mind; imperfect with potential.

#### 1. Deadline and Criteria for Inclusion

- **a. Deadline:** Plays can be read in the Writers Workshop starting now until Tuesday, May 7, 2019.
- b. To be Included in the Series
  i. Plays should be read in the Writers Workshop
  ii. Plays should be rewritten.
  iii.Rewrite should be read in the Writers Workshop before May 7th.

#### 2. Days and Dates of the Reading Series

- a. Reading Series will start Sunday night, June 2, 2019
  i. As part of "Sundays at Seven"
- b. It will run every Sunday night until all included plays are read
   i. Could be as long as 10 weeks, or as short as 4 weeks.
- **c**. Co-moderators will know before May 7th how many plays will be ready for their first public reading.
- 3. Responsibilities of each writer on the night of their reading
  - a. Act as own producer
  - **b.** Find director
  - c. Cast
  - d. Provide refreshments and snacks to guests after reading
  - e. Find someone to sell concessions before and at intermission (if there is an intermission)
  - f. Find an usher for the evening

#### 4. Flyer

- a. Doug Haverty has agreed to do the flyer.
- 5. AB Liaisons and Decisions
  - **a** The Writers Workshop Co-moderators will be the liaison to the board in the event a vote must be taken for a play in the reading series.
  - **b.** Writers Workshop Co-moderators will counsel each writer on play's readiness for its first public reading


